Turkey Place Card Directions

Materials Needed:

- Creativity Street® Pom Pons Class Pack
- Creativity Street® Duck Quill Feathers
- Creativity Street® Wiggle Eyes Assortment
- Tru-Ray® Heavyweight Construction Paper
- Turkey Pattern (attached)
- Scissors
- Double-sided Tape
- Glue
- Marker

Step 1:

Using the Turkey Pattern, cut the feet and beak out of Yellow Tru-Ray® Heavyweight Construction Paper. Cut the throat wattle out of Red Tru-Ray® Construction Paper.

Step 2:

Glue a large pom pon to the feet. Add one small pom pon on top of this for the turkey's head. With the last two pom pons use a scissors to cut one side of each pom pon flat. These will be the wings. Glue the flat side of each pom pon to the sides of the turkey's body.



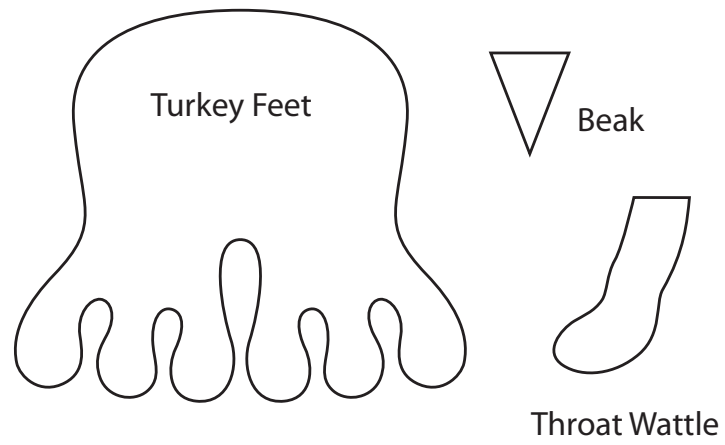
Step 3:

Glue quill feathers to the back side of the turkey. Glue the yellow beak to the red throat wattle, and glue this to the turkey's head. Glue on wiggle eyes, and your turkey is complete!

Step 4:

Cut $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{4}$ " name card out of Yellow Tru-Ray® Heavyweight Construction Paper. Write guest's name with a marker, and add it to the front of the turkey with a piece of double-sided tape.
